McLaren Vale Cabernet Sauvignon 2005 Filled to the gills with blackcurrant fruit and an echo of dark chocolate; good tannin and oak management; will likely outlive its cork closure. **RATING 94 TO 2020**



McLaren Vale Shiraz 2005 Deep, dense colour; a powerful, layered and structured wine; masses of blackberry fruit with a touch of chocolate; ripe tannins. **RATING 93 TO 2020**

White Boar 2005 Powerful, rich and deep; the prune-like sweetness in Amarone style is the result of cane cutting and up to 2 weeks drying before vinification. **RATING 90 TO 2025**



The War of the Rose 2006 Light red-purple; crisp, lively, vibrant and fresh red cherry/ redcurrant fruit; good length. Cabernet Sauvignon. **RATING 89 TO 2008**

McLaren Vale Shiraz Viognier 2005 Rich confit fruit; sweetness (fruit and alcohol) apparent throughout; may settle down and dry out a little with time. **RATING 89 TO 2015**

McLaren Vale Chardonnay Viognier 2006 Flavoursome wine; stone fruit, especially including apricots, bears testament to the blend; no oak obvious. **RATING 87 TO 2015**
